Parish council news

Vacancy for a councillor: Council members are seeking to co-opt an additional councillor to fill the seat which has been vacant since the elections in May 2017. Applications will be considered at the council meeting on July 10th and if you would like to be considered please get in touch with the clerk, who will advise you on how to apply.

Finance: At the council meeting held on June 12th. Members approved the income and expenditure accounts for the previous year and the report from the internal auditor, who raised no concerns about the management of council business or the financial transactions. The necessary documents now have to be sent for consideration to the external auditor, appointed by the government and their report will be considered by members later in the year. A copy of the income and expenditure accounts will be posted on the council web site - www.shawbury-pc.gov.uk later this month or can be obtained on request from the Parish Clerk.

Church burial ground: It was recently discovered that there are un-attended graves in the burial ground of some service personnel who died in the First World War. With the agreement of the church wardens, councillors Jill Manley and Sam McIntosh are going to be working with a group of personnel from RAF Shawbury to refurbish these graves, in recognition of the ultimate sacrifices the men made.

Reminder: Council members wish to remind everyone that Parish Council meetings are held in the Village Hall normally on the second Tuesday of the month starting at 7.00pm. Agendas for the meeting are placed on the council notice board and on the web site well before the date of the meetings which are open to members of the public, who have an opportunity to raise issues or concerns prior to the start of the official meeting. If you have a particular issue or item you would like the council to consider at a meeting, contact the clerk well before the date to enable it to be included on the agenda.
