Shropshire Maternity Mental Health Provision

one of the worst in the country

The Maternal Mental Health Alliance has published data that shows that the level of specialist support given to Shropshire women and their families is “extremely basic” and “falls short of national standards”. Healthwatch Shropshire would like to know what support people feel is needed to ensure their whole family is supported with mental health challenges during or after pregnancy. Over half of new mothers are concerned about their mental health and as many as 1 in 5 pregnant women and new mums experience some form of mental health challenge. Partners can also be affected: the National Childbirth Trust research shows that 1 in 3 new dads are concerned about their mental health and 1 in 10 dads suffer from Post Natal Depression. It is a subject that has been gathering widespread attention of late and Healthwatch Shropshire would like to know how this has affected families in the area. “You can help by sharing your experience or encouraging anyone you know who might be affected to take five minutes to share their story. All information will be treated confidentially and shared anonymously.”


