### Parish Council News:

#### Community Service Awards—Sponsored By RAF Shawbury

Each year the Parish Council presents Community Service Awards to residents or workers in the Parish, who have been nominated for giving outstanding service to the Community.

There are two levels of award – (a) for adults and (b) for those under eighteen years of age and there is no restriction on the number that can be awarded each year.

Elected Councillors can only be nominated for community activity which is not related to their responsibilities as a Councillor.

Nominations for the award may be made by local parishioners and forwarded to the Parish Clerk before **March 31<sup>st</sup>**. with supporting information about the reasons the person is being nominated. Members will consider the applications at the Parish Council meeting on April 10<sup>th</sup>. and those who are successful will be informed of their award and invited to attend the Annual Parish Meeting on May 22<sup>nd</sup>. when the awards will be presented.
